Residents

1. Pre-register for the Producer Casualty exam at www.pearsonvue.com/ak/insurance for \$89.00.
 - a. Practice tests are available for \$19.95.
2. Register for fingerprinting at www.pearsonvue.com/ak/insurance for \$47.00
3. Apply online for your license with the National Insurance Producer Registry at www.nipr.com
 - a. Apply for the Resident Producer Casualty
 - b. License fee is \$122.00 plus a \$5.00 transaction fee.
 - c. Please allow 5-7 days for license to process

Non-Residents

Canadian Residents are not eligible to apply for the Alaska license.

All nonresidents must hold a Producer Casualty license in their state of residence before applying for the Alaska Producer Casualty license. Then, you may apply for the Alaska Producer Casualty license following the procedures listed below.

1. Apply online for your license with the National Insurance Producer Registry at www.nipr.com
 - a. Apply for the Non-Resident Producer Casualty
 - b. License fee is \$75.00 plus a \$6.18 transaction fee.
 - c. Please allow 5-7 days for license to process
2. Go to www.statebasedsystems.com to print your license.
3. Submit a copy of your license and your associate number by mail, email, or fax to:

The Alaska license expires biennially in your birth month depending on your birth year. If you were born in an even year, your license will expire in an even year (example: 1978). If you were born in an odd year, your license will expire in an odd year (example: 1979).
