Note: **Nonresidents** will have to provide proof of extraterritorial registration

- 1. Complete the Northwest Territories Direct Sellers paper application.
 - a. You may obtain the application by selecting here.
 - b. You will only need to complete the Direct Seller portion of the application.
 - c. Vendor name PPL Legal Care of Canada
- 2. A certified criminal record check is required. You can use any appropriate background check from a valid police force in the jurisdiction you reside in.
- 3. You will forward the completed application and the appropriate license fee to:
